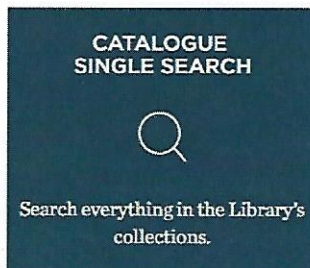

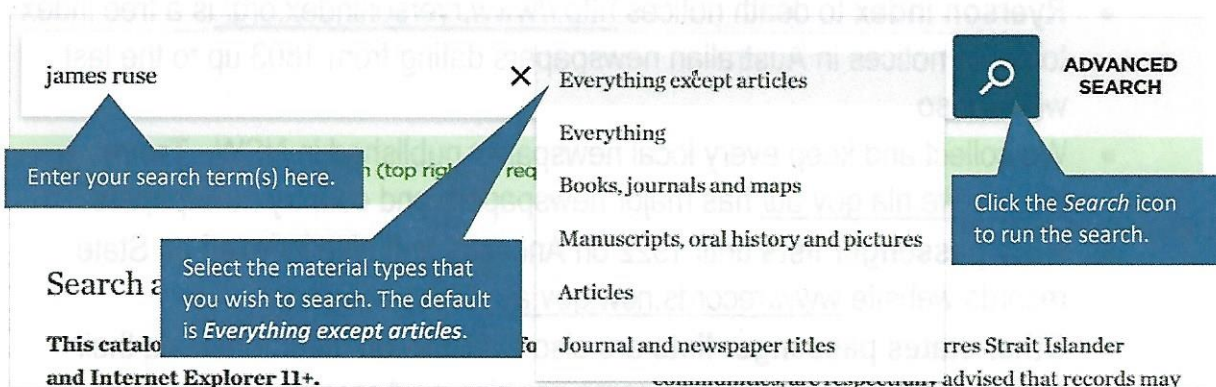
- **NSW Births, Deaths and Marriages**  
<http://www.bdm.nsw.gov.au/Pages/family-history/family-history.aspx>
- We have **NSW Registers of Baptisms, Burials and Marriages** from 1787-1856 on microfilm
- We have many **NSW Church Registers** on microfilm, some pre-1856
- **Ryerson index** to death notices <http://www.ryersonindex.org/> is a free index to death notices in Australian newspapers dating from 1803 up to the last week or so
- We collect and keep every local newspaper published in NSW. **Trove** <http://trove.nla.gov.au/> has major newspapers and country newspapers
- **NSW passenger lists** until 1922 on Ancestry and also indexed on State records website [www.records.nsw.gov.au](http://www.records.nsw.gov.au)
- **Other states passenger lists** are also available on the Internet via their Archives offices websites and some are also on Ancestry
- **Post 1922 passengers lists** on NAA website [www.naa.gov.au](http://www.naa.gov.au)
- We hold **electoral rolls** on microfiche for all states of Australia until 2008. For NSW from 1842-2008. Ancestry & Findmypast have digitised some electoral rolls also
- **Sands Directories 1858-1932** At the Library on microfiche or online at <http://www.cityofsydney.nsw.gov.au/learn/search-our-collections/sands-directory>
- We hold **NSW telephone books** from 1889 onwards on microfiche
- **Cemetery records** many of these are held in the Mitchell Library and also on Findmypast and on CDROM
- Best sources for international genealogy are electronic: use **Ancestry Library** and **Findmypast** for England, Wales, Scotland and Ireland and North America. Try [familysearch.org](http://familysearch.org) for everything else

- Use the Library's powerful single search catalogue to explore our collection of over 6 million items

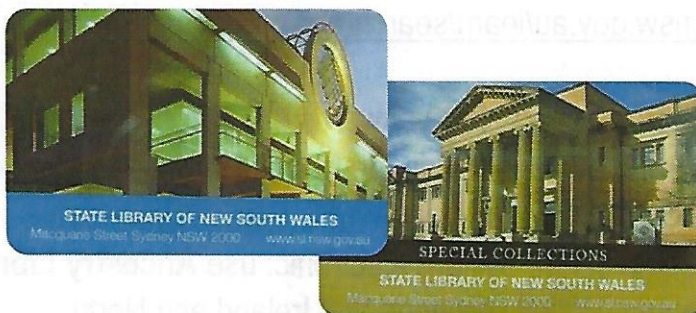


- Published collections (books, magazines, newspapers)
- Unpublished collections (manuscripts, oral histories, pictures)
- Digital content (digitised by the Library or acquired in a digital format)
- Most e-resources (ebooks, journal articles and databases)
- The catalogue defaults to searching *Everything except articles*



- Use the drop-down menu on the right of the text entry box to select other options eg. *Manuscripts, oral history and pictures* or *Archival digital*

## LIBRARY CARDS



- Library membership is free and access to our electronic resources is available to all New South Wales residents
- 'Blue' cards offer access to published material including e-resources
- 'Gold' cards give you access to published (including e-resources) and original material such as manuscripts, pictures and oral history. Original material is accessed in the Mitchell building
